

SUPERSEDED QUALIFICATIONS

These qualifications have become superseded across Australia. This means that all Registered Training Organisations, such as Sea School International is endorsed. Students enrolling in any of the qualifications listed below **MUST** complete the qualification by the 'Transition Date' which is 08 July 2019 OR transition to the new qualification when it becomes available.

Sea School is reviewing all qualifications and updating and developing resources in line with the new qualifications. We are also devising a strategy to make the transition as smooth as possible to avoid disrupting your learning.

Students will **not be financially disadvantaged** by starting the qualification currently on offer. If you do not complete by the transition date you **must transfer** to the new qualification. Sea School will notify you to let you know when this will happen.
